Frequently Asked Questions

When did the City of Mackinac Island Ordinance, amendment to Chapter 66 regarding E-Bikes take effect?

The new ordinance took effect April 29, 2026.

What should I know about the qualifications for mobility disability? Review the ordinance closely, specifically the definition of “qualified person with a mobility disability section 66 – 167”. Consider your own personal needs and health conditions, as it relates to the criteria listed.

How do I respond if I believe I have a mobility disability and don’t have a handicap parking placard, a state issued proof of disability, or a statement from a medical provider?

Call to request an appointment with your primary care provider.

What if I don’t have a primary care provider? You will need to schedule an appointment with a primary care provider of your choosing.

Can the Mackinac Island Medical Center help? Yes. However, priority will be given to established patients.

What can I expect for the cost of the visit if I have health insurance? You will be required to submit your co-pay at the time of the visit. Co-pays will vary, depending on individual insurance plans. You may experience additional costs if lab and/or radiology services are deemed necessary.

What can I expect for the cost if the visit if I don’t have health insurance? The office visit will cost between \$145 to \$200. You will be responsible for payment in full at the time of service. You may experience additional costs if lab and/or radiology services are deemed necessary.
